

Dear Tribal Members,



Council Meeting

Georgetown Tribal Council March 26, 2023 Quarterly Meeting

The Georgetown Tribal Council, the governing body of the Native Village of Georgetown, met on Saturday, June 24th, 2023, for their quarterly meeting. Council Members that attended in-person were Traci Maczynski, Gary Fredericks, and Valerie Dudley. Jonathan Samuelson, and David Kutch attended remotely by Teams. Others in attendance Irene Venes (by phone).

During the meeting the Council:

- Approved the agenda with added agenda items.
- Approved the meeting minutes for March 26, 2023, quarterly meeting.
- Reviewed Administrative reports from the Tribal Administrator and staff members.
- Heard committee reports from the Environmental Committee, Land Committee, Enrollment Committee, Policy Committee, Pre-Audit Committee, and Community Center Committee.
- Approved the pending enrollment application conditional on receiving/review birth certificate.
- Directed the Tribal Administrator to submit intervention paperwork in an ICWA case.
- Agreed to hold a strategic planning session by the end of July.
- Received an update on the planning for the upcoming annual meeting
- Discussed the need to update the Georgetown constitution and directed the staff to review the process of a Secretarial election and report back.
- Approve the Finance Committee Policy and created the Finance Committee
- Dissolved the Pre-Audit Committee and those duties will fall under the Finance Committee
- Appointed council members to serve on the Finance Committee
- Approved the budgeting process policy, single-use budget policy.
- Approved Resolution 23-02 which selected a delegate and an alternate for the 2023 AVCP Convention. Gary Fredricks will be the delegate and David Kutch will be the alternate.
- Jonathan Samuelson gave an update on the Intertribal Fish Commission
- Set the next meeting date for October 14th at 11 AM
- Adjourned
